Note: The letters "BT" had been scribed on top of the <u>cut</u> area of the stump.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: Set a 1"x30" galvanized pipe with a 3" brass cap stamped:

A White Fir 12" dia bears N50⁰E 60.7 ft scribed ½ S5 BT.

Attached 54-3 & 54-4 signs to both BT's. Attached brass washers stamped LS 1294 to foot blaze of both BT's. Painted blazes and 6" band around both BT's red.
