## History of original corner establishment:

The original surveyor George Williams under G.L.O. Contract No. 176, 1872 set a post from which:

A White Fir 30" dia. bears S32<sup>0</sup>W 49 1ks.

A White Fir 15" dia. bears N18<sup>0</sup>W 72 1ks.

In 1899 a resurvey was performed by George R. and William C. Campbell under G.L.O. Contract No. 699. They found the corner and BTs set by Williams in 1872.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found: Original SW bearing tree, and original 30" White Fir, now a 36" broken snag about 10' tall with visible scribing "B" on previously opened blaze. Open further and find scribing "S ¼ BT". Unable to find post or stone replacing post. No trace of original NW BT.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At record bearing and distance from original BT, set a 1"x30" Galvanized Pipe with a 3" brass cap stamped:

Set corner 24" in ground.

Attached 54-3 and 54-4 signs to both BTs. Attached brass washers stamped LS 1294 to foot blaze of both BTs. Painted blazes and 6" band around both BTs red.

## Bearing Trees:

A Spruce 6" dia. bears N31<sup>0</sup>W 43.5 ft., scribed: ½ S8 BT. A Spruce 11" dia. bears S71<sup>0</sup>W 9.1 ft., scribed: ½ S8 BT.
