Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 10 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap. Set steel fence post on property line South and East of corner and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Established 2 new BT's: A 16" red fir bears S70°E 26.9 ft. scribed S 1/16 S 19 BT.

A 9" red fir bears S 17°W 10.0 ft. scribed S 1/16 S 24 BT. This tree has been blazed like it was

thought to be near the corner (4 sides).

BT's have lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to it.

BT's have 54-3 and 54-4 signs attached and a 6" red band painted around them above blaze.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 192° east declination. Measured to center of Bts.
