No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found basalt stone 12"x10"x8" marked $\frac{1}{5}$ on West face firmly set in a mound of stone. From which the ORIGINAL BEARING TREE:

A 24" pine snag bears N. 57° W. 34.3 ft. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT. The other BT has been removed in construction of a fence line.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: Set a 2½"x30" galvanized iron pipe 16" in the ground with brass cap marked as shown. From which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

A 10" pine brs. N. 26° E. 43.5ft. mkd. T5S R30E ½ S36 BT. A 10" pine brs. S. 77° W. 42.3ft. mkd. T5S R30E ½ S35 BT.

I nailed a brass washer mkd "OPLS 598" to the BT blaze of both trees. Set a steel fence post 5' North of corner. Buried original corner stone South and alongside pipe. Surrounded corner with mound of stone. Used compass with 20° East variation and steel tape, measuring to center of BTs.
