Description of corner evidence found:

Found old BT on ground, Location could not be found. We did not use it.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" iron pipe 27" in ground with a brass cap marked as shown: From which I scribed New Bearing Trees.

A 9" fir bears N. 76°49"W 31.0 ft. mkd. ± S.33 SC BT. A 12" fir bears N. 63° 58' E 15.7 ft. mkd. ± S.33 SC BT.

I nailed a brass cap mkd. PLS 933 on BT blaze to both trees. Set a steel fence post 4 ft. East of corner. Corner is 32 ft. North of E-W fence line. Used transit and steel tape, measuring to the center of BTs.
