CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established in 1880 by George S. Pershin, under Contract No. 361

Surveyor General Record States:

Fir 10 in. diam. brs N. 51° W. 15 lks. dist. Fir 24 in. diam. brs S. 8° W. 23 lks. dist.

No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found a basalt stone 12x8x5 dimly marked 1/4. From which the ORIGINAL BEARING TREES:

The remains of an 8" Fir stump bears N. 51° W. 9.9 ft. The blaze marked $\frac{1}{4}S$ BT was alongside this stump.

The remains of a completely deteriorated fir brs. S. 8° W. 15.2 feet. This BT was destroyed by construction of old skid road.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: Set a 2½"x30" galvanized iron pipe 22" in the ground with brass cap marked as shown. From which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

A 22" pine bears N. 53° E. 48.0 ft. mkd. T5S R30E $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 SC BT. A 16" tamarack bears N. 74° W. 35.1 ft. mkd. T5S R30E $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 SC BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked "OPLS 598" to the BT blaze of both trees. Set steel fence post 5 ft. West of corner. Buried original corner stone West and alongside pipe. Raised mound of stone 3 ft. base to top of pipe. Corner is 6 feet North of E-W fenceline and 70 ft. West of a dry creek. Used compass with 20° East variation and steel tape, measuring to the center of the new BTs.
