Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 30" iron pipe with brass cap 15" in ground, put the stone along side pipe: brass cap marked as shown, from which I scribed new Bearing Tree. A 26" pine bears N. 38<sup>°</sup> E. 70.6 ft. mkd T.5 S., R. 30 E.,  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. 35 BT

I nailed a brass washer marked PLS 933 to the BT blaze of both trees. Set steel post 2 ft. West of corner. Corner is 75 ft. South of E-W Road and 97 ft. North of E-W fence line. Raised stone mound 3 ft. base within 4" to top of pipe. Used transit and steel tape, measuring to center of BT.
