Description of corner evidence found:

Found stone 6"x12"x17" set in a mound of stone, no mks visible. Set on South face of bluff. From which:

A dead and down 23" pine bears N. 71° E. 70.6 ft. mkd T5S R31E S31 SC BT (Orig. BT) No evidence of the other BT was found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: Set a 2½"x30" iron pipe 18" in the ground. From which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

A 31" pine brs. N. 30° E. 141.0 ft. mkd T5S R31E S31 SC BT. An 18" pine brs. N. 47° W. 95.4 ft. mkd T5S R30E S36 SC BT.

I nailed a brass washer mkd "OPLS 598" to the BT blaze of both trees. Set a steel fence post 5 ft. North of corner. Buried original corner stone west and alongside iron pipe. Raised a mound of stone 3' base to top of pipe. Corner is 200 ft. North of Five Mile Creek road. Used compass with 20° East variation and steel tape, measuring to center of BTs.
