Description of corner evidence found:

Found basalt stone 16"x8"x7" marked with 5 notches on E. edge and 1 notch on W. edge, firmly set in a mound of stone. From which the ORIGINAL BEARING TREES:

A 22" pine bears N. 69° W. 22.4 ft. mkd. T5S S31 SC BT in weathered blaze. A stump hole bears N. 38° E. 14.5 ft., no remains of this BT found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: Set a  $2\frac{l_2}{x}30$ " iron pipe 20" in the ground with brass cap marked as shown. From which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

A 10" pine bears N. 71° E. 49.2 ft. mkd. T5S R30E S32 SC BT. An 8" pine bears N. 22° W. 10.5 ft. mkd. T5S R30E S31 SC BT.

I nailed a brass washer mkd "OPLS 598" to the BT blaze of both trees. Set a steel fence post 5 ft. East of corner. Buried original corner stone W and alongside pipe. Raised mound of stone 3 ft. base to within 3" of top of pipe. Corner is 22 ft. N. of E-SW fence line. Used compass with 20° East variation and steel tape, measuring to center of new BTs.
