Previous Renewals/Surveys, etc.: This corner was originally set by U.S. Deputy Surveyors William Odell and William Lewis under their contract No. 110 dated February 7. 1865. The Surveyor Generals notes state "set post corner, drove charred stake, dug pits and raised mounds per instructions". County Survey No. 280, Book 2 Page 105, by Kimbrell, dated March 15, 1909, indicates that he found the corner but does not descibe what he found. As shown on County Survey No. 00-31-C, dated February 23, 2000, Paul Tomkins set a 5/8"x 30" iron rebar with a 2" aluminum cap by double proportion.

On the Southwest Corner of Section 23, T6N R34E, found a 2" rebar with Aluminum Cap 7" below the surface of the gravel road.
