Corner originally set by County Surveyor Willard Bradley under survey Q-813-A dated March 1914. His record reads: "Stone". County Surveyor Aubrey Perry reestablished this corner under the survey recorded in Book 2, Page 306 of the Record of Private Surveys. His record reads: "Set rock for 1/16th corner."

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The granite stone set by Perry 16" x 12" x 7", set 6" below the surface at the corner to fences running east and northwest.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) I set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the position of Perry's stone. The cap was flush with the ground. I set a 5' steel guard post with a county monument sign attached along side. I buried the stone at the foot of the pipe.

For references, I set two, 5/8" by 24" green coated iron rebars with 1.25" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below: an iron rebar bears N86°04'36"E, 22.99 feet, under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears N46°31'57"W, 20.79 feet, under the existing fence;
