The Surveyor Generals notes state "set post corner, drove charred stake, dug pits and raised mounds per instructions". In May, 1902 County Surveyor McComber (Co. Book 1, Page 464) shows astone at the corner. In March, 1909 County Surveyor Kimbrell (Co. Book 2, Page 105) visits the corner, but does not identify it. In 1988, Steamer shows a "3/4" pipe in fence corner" (Co. Survey 97-46-A). In 1998, Bartleson shows a "corner post" (Co. Survey 98-108-B).
