Found a 3½ ins. BLM brass cap on a 2½ ins. iron pipe as noted by BLM Survey marked ¼ S23 and S24, T6N, R37E 1965, on a steep North facing slope with moderate underbrush and mature fir trees. The point is approximately 50 ft. S. of a creek bed ravine and approximately 40 ft. higher in elevation than the creek bed.

Fir tree 13 ins. diam., with healed blaze, no bearing tag found as noted by BLM, the tree is now 26 ins. diam., the tree was painted and tagged, bears N. $82\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 57.4 ft.

Fir tree 18 ins. diam., bears S. 63° E., 19.1 ft. dist., with healed blaze and bearing tag as noted by BLM. The tree is now 26 ins. diam., and was painted and tagged.

Fir tree 15 ins. diam. bears S. 15¹/₂° W., 28.4 ft. dist., as noted by BLM was found uprooted and down. The stump hole is at the BLM noted location and was accepted as bearing location.

Fir tree 15 ins. diam., bears N. 48¹/₂° W., 87.1 ft. dist., with healed blaze and bearing tag as noted by BLM. The tree is now 22 ins. diam., the tree was painted and said tree is across the creek bed ravine.
