

Public Transportation Service Providers (PTSP's) and eligible sub-recipients are hereby notified that Umatilla County is currently accepting applications for the 2023-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund (STIF) Plan and STIF Discretionary/Statewide Transit Network grants.

STIF FORMULA (NOW INCLUDES STF PROJECTS)

Interested Public Transportation Service Providers and sub-recipients (see definition found in OAR 732-040-0005) who are eligible, shall complete the STIF Formula Plan Template available online at the following link:

Completed STIF plan templates must be submitted to Megan Davchevski, Umatilla County Transit Coordinator, by submitting projects on the bottom of the application form. Applications are due by 5:00 pm on Friday, November 11, 2022. Applications will be reviewed and ranked by the Umatilla County Transportation Advisory Committee (UCTAC) in accordance with the Bylaws and Oregon Administrative Rules. The UCTAC will make a recommendation to the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners, who will determine the final selection of projects and funding amounts.

STIF Discretionary/STN LOI are due to ODOT no later than October 10, 2022. Early submittal is encouraged.
